FEATURES

- Wide array of shapes for flexible design options. Straight and curved modular pieces, with or without backs, power options.
- Line includes occasional tables with laminate tops to sit next to or in the middle of a seating section.
- Curved lounge pieces and rounded end units create fluid seating areas without abrupt edges.

SEATING MATERIALS

- The lounge frames are constructed of puzzle cut 7/8" thick plywood with locking dog bone joint construction that is glued and stapled.
- The seats are strapped with Elasbelt®
 Elastic Webbing and commercial quality
 4" polyurethane foam on the seat top for comfort, 2" foam on back, and 1" thick foam on the front and sides.
- Fabrics of Grade 2 or higher are recommended. Selections up to Grade 10 available. Options include over 50 standard fabrics and hundreds of designer fabrics to choose from. See our website for selections.
- Contrasting fabrics are available for all upholstered modules. When selecting contrasting upholstery, clearly specify which fabric should be used for the

base, seat, back, and arms. Use the higher grade for pricing purposes.

FEET ON SEATING AND TABLES

- Metal legs are 4-3/4" tall, 1-11/16" diameter turned aluminum with securely attached to furniture frame with a sturdy metal threaded rod.
- 3" x 1.25" wide, 4-3/4" high poly swivel lock, non-marking casters are used for all pieces. They are attached to furniture base with a sturdy metal plate secured with screws.

OCCASIONAL TABLE MATERIALS



- The occasional tables are constructed of 1" particle board core with high pressure laminate on both faces and a 3mm PVC external band on all visible edges.
- Grade 1 laminates are standard, with options for higher grades, upcharges per the price list. See our website for options.
- Tables are constructed with an recessed panel on both sides.
- The top cushions and fabric inset panels are attached to the tables with industrial hook and loop tape.












Main 1 | Seat Top 2






90° Inner Curve






