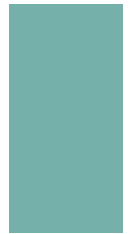

Scope of Project: **Why did Franklin Library choose Hive?**

“Franklin Public Library chose to purchase two Nomad Hive configurations in lieu of building additional small group meeting rooms. 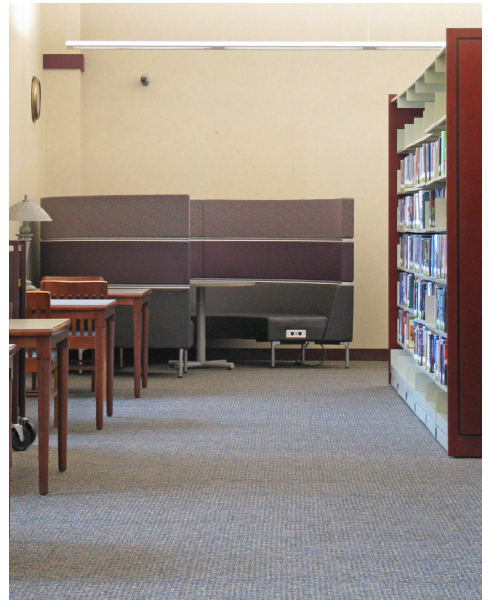
Design Focus:

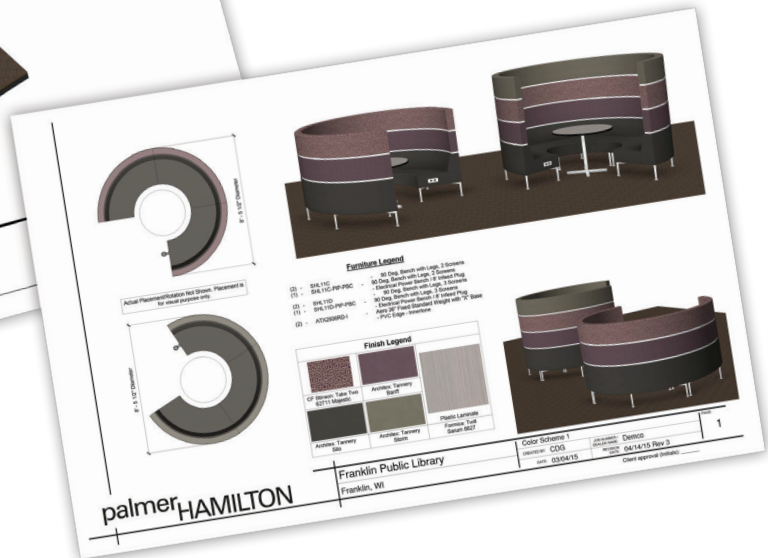
Furniture:
