

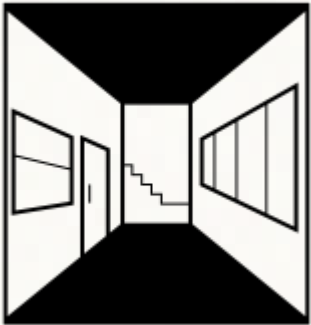
Top 4 Tips for Successful Install



1. Know Your Truck Access

- Our delivery truck is a 53-foot semi-trailer, totaling approximately 70–72 feet in length and about 14 feet in height.
- Full access to the project site is required to accommodate the semi-trailer.
- Please identify and plan for any potential obstacles such as:
 - Low-hanging trees
 - Power lines
 - Tight turns or narrow driveways

2. Understand Site Obstacles



- Be aware of access details like:
 - Steps
 - Ramps
 - Doorways
 - Hallways
- **Be specific:** Let us know the exact number of steps (e.g., “3 steps,” not just “a few steps”).
- The more detailed the information, the smoother the installation will be.

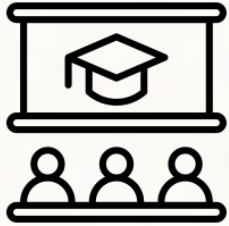

3. Educate The Staff

- Ensure all staff who will use the product daily are familiar with it before installation.
- Conduct a demo and allow hands-on practice to increase comfort and confidence.
- Review proper maintenance procedures to extend the life of the product.



4. Have a Disposal Plan for Old Product

- Ensure a dumpster is available **on-site before installation day.**
- Without proper disposal arrangements, the installation may be delayed due to lack of space for removal of the old product.
